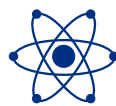

New Student Support Network

PEER ADVISOR (PA)

Student mentor who helps support new students navigate campus and transition to college life during thirs first semester.

CORNERSTONES MENTOR

Cornerstones mentors teach the first-year experience course (Cornerstones) and often acts as the academic advisor for the students in that course. The PAs support the mentors and sit in on class with the new students.

RESIDENT ASSISTANT (RA)

All students living on campus have a resident assistant or RA. The RA lives on the same floor and works to build community within the living area. This means regularly communicating events and ensuring guidelines are being followed in the hall.

RESIDENT DIRECTOR (RD) & COMMUTER SUPPORT

Each living area has a resident director or RD who supervises the hall and the RAs in that living area. Hannah Eisen is the staff member who serves as the primary support person for commuter students.

SPIRITUAL LIFE ASSISTANT (SLA)

Spiritual life assistants are located on each floor or living area. They host weekly devotionals and offer spiritual support.

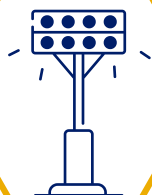
